## 1 Welcome

John thanked everyone for attending and introduced the purpose of this the 2014 AGM. John noted the earlier rainbow – God's promise of a blessing on our meeting! A period of worship followed. John, speaking from Paul's Letter to the Colossians, invited us to resolve to work and pray together and to encourage each other. Though widely spread out across the community, in the words of Paul, may we "grow in the riches of Christ" together.

# 3 Overview of the past year's achievements

All of last year's activities were considered largely successful.

### 3.1 Finances

The Treasurer's Report was received (Appendix 1). The FACT General Fund balance at the end of the year was £3680.

It was later agreed:

- a) To pay £150 to the Holiday Bible Club to help resource their summer programme
- b) That advertisements for Christmas and Easter should be paid from subscriptions.



#### 3.2 Website

The new website has had over 4,500 visits since its introduction last year and is regularly viewed on a daily basis.

It was agreed that:

- a) A link to the currently hidden "internal FACT" agenda page should be added to the home page banner on the basis that we should be able to be open about how we work
- b) We should all look at the website at least weekly to keep up to date.

#### 3.3 FACT Events

a) Frome Show

It was agreed that, rather than paying for our own tent, we would contribute to the Postlebury tent instead.

b) Alphas

Very encouraging Reports were received from both the Beckington and Frome Alpha Courses (Appendix 2).

c) United Service

The Rook Lane venue was considered particularly good.

A Report was received regarding the Lent Lunch activities (Appendix 3).

## 3.4 Hope Frome Report

A Report was received from HOPE Frome (Appendix 4). It was noted that more volunteers are still needed. We need to consider whether FACT is supporting HOPE Frome as much as is possible, noting the last paragraph of their report in particular.

3.5 Holiday Bible Club

A Report was received from the Holiday Bible Club (Appendix 5). See the agreements noted above under Finance.

3.6 HOTS

Although no Report was received this time, it was again noted that more volunteers are needed here too.

3.7 Hospital Chaplaincy

It was noted that a regional coordinating chaplain is to be appointed, following which local arrangements will be confirmed.

3.9 Food Bank and YMCA

A Report was received covering both activities (Appendix 6).

3.10 Filling Station

This was considered a blessing in 2013-2014.

3.11 Youth Worker Proposals

The current proposal is that the Youth Worker will be emplyed by a church (currently Holy Trinity) with a proportion of his/her time ear-marked for general FACT activities (e.g. schools work) supported by our contribution. The status of the proposals is that the vacancy is to be advertised shortly in all the supporting churches.

- 4.2 John thanked Janet Caudwell, Maurice Dobbs and Rev Martin Weymont for all their past work.
