### Finance Report.

- Current subscriptions: £865 paid. £665 outstanding (please remind your Treasurer!)
- Balances: HopeFrome £1364; Youth Fund £3809; General Fund £3550
- It was agreed to pay World Sports Ministries £750 as FACT contribution to the Get Sported camps (to cover cost of bibles, brochures and bursaries)

### **Looking Back** (brief reflections):

- Website deep appreciation expressed to Peter Craig for his monitoring
- Monthly prayer meeting (1<sup>st</sup> Saturday on each month, St John's 8.45-9.30am) established
- **Pentecost Praise** a good site and good to be outside in centre of town.
- **Frome Festival** food fest and Music events appreciated. Possibility of Songs of Praise event in 2015.
- Holiday Bible Club see report on separate e mail. 59 children (37 unchurched); 11 churches involved; well advertised in local newspaper (thank you, Jim); followed by Alternative Halloween 4.30-6.30pm at Trinity Church Hall on Friday 31 October
- **Get Sported.** Leadership training being planned in coming months **Nick Cooper (Baptist)** working with World Sports Ministries. He would welcome support from any interested.
- Youth Work post. Bryce Tangvald was introduced as the recently appointed Trinity/FACT Youth Worker (part-time), having been interviewed by Graham Owen, Jim Parsons and Brigit Adams. He will be commissioned at the United Fact Service at Rook Lane Arts on Sunday 12 October at 6.00pm.

# **Looking Forward:**

- 1. Reshaping FACT. An interesting discussion ensued reflecting on:
  - The changing 'shape' of the church viz. Congregational Church vacating its building, history of Rook Lane Chapel; age structure of church; sacred/secular divide ....
  - The changing shape of 'Churches Together' in the UK (see their annual report): organisational to provisional, structures to relationships, constitutions to covenants. i.e. a greater fluidity
  - It was commented that 'Frome Christians Together' is preferable to 'Frome Churches Together' reflecting the changes noted above.

- The goal of FACT is to 'spur one another on toward love and good deeds ....... and to encourage one another to draw near to God and to hold unswervingly to the hope we have in Christ' (see Heb 10:22-25 the passage with which the meeting opened)
- Facing the challenges of the future, the church needs to change and so does FACT. Our relational integrity and commitment to prayer are fundamental to this change being realised.
- FACT is indebted to those who work behind the scenes, especially **Janet**, **Jim**, **Ian and Peter**.

# 2. Reshaping HopeFrome.

- The 3 Hope Frome Trustees who have established the 'HOPEFrome brand' so strongly over the past 6 years have to step down Anna is moving, Mike is returning overseas and Phil has a new job. They formally signed a document handing over the responsibility of the trusteeship of HOPEFrome to FACT.
- A unanimous vote of thanks was given the Phil, Anna and Mike for all their hard work and visionary commitment to HOPEFrome; retiring Chair Jackie Chilvers, together with all those who support the Van, Litter Picks and Food Fest arrangements were also thanked for all their hard, faithful work. It was affirmed that the 'HOPEFrome brand' must remain as an essential element in the presence and purpose of FACT.
- Chris and Jane Stafford (Trinity Church) were proposed and seconded as custodians of the HOPEFrome portfolio for FACT and this was passed unanimously with gratitude. It was agreed that it was important to find another custodian alongside Chris and Jane and Colin Alsbury offered to fulfil this role until the post was filled (ideally at our next meeting)
- It was recognised that the development of Fair Frome and other community initiatives provide a number of platforms for HOPEFrome to engage with and this will be explored in the coming months.

- Publicity for Christmas services newspapers/website. Jim agreed to collate the information for the newspapers. <u>Please send Jim details of your church services for Christmas by end</u> <u>October.</u> Payment is included in the subscriptions.
- 8. Week of Prayer for Christian Unity: 18-25 January (Sun 18<sup>th</sup> = pulpit exchange **Jim**). <u>Jim</u> needs details of availability for preaching by end October.
