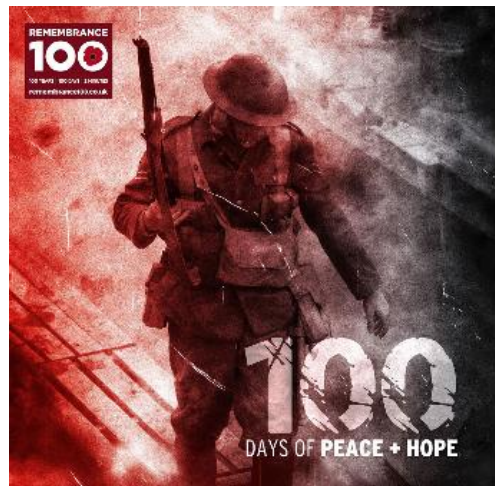


REMEMBRANCE 100

HOPE

Sunday August 4th 1918 – King George V and Queen Mary joined The House Of Commons and The House of Lords for a special service at The Church of St Margaret Westminster. War with Germany had been declared 4 years earlier (4th August 1914). The King had asked that the 4th of August 1918 be declared a National Day of Prayer. The war ended 100 days later, on November 11th 1918.

November 11th is commemorated each year with an Armistice Day Service, and of course this year is 100 years after the first Armistice Day.



Remembrance 100 is a collaboration, between Christian denominations, ministries and chaplaincies to help churches mark the centenary of the First World War at the heart of their communities.
